

# BIKE THE NEW YORK CITY WATERFALLS CUE SHEET

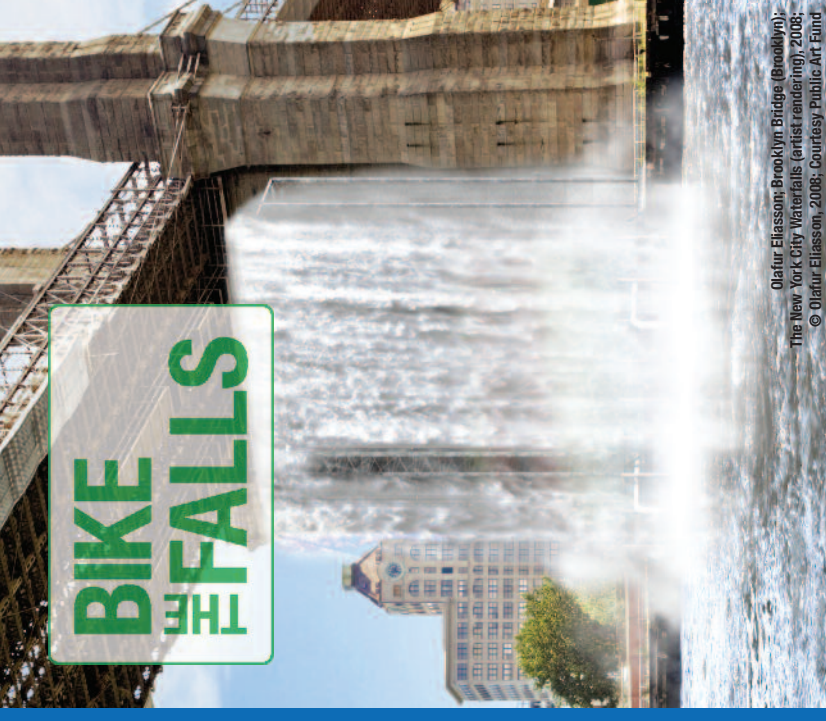
**Route Info:** To complement the route map and cue sheet, and to aid cyclists, blue chevrons accompanied by the Waterfalls icon have been installed on the roadway to delineate the route.

<b>START</b>	<b>City Hall/Centre Street</b>		0.0	Opposite Brooklyn Bridge
Straight	Brooklyn Bridge Promenade Bike Path	1.5	1.5	Put bike in low gear for ascent on bridge.
Right	Tillary Street Bike Path	0.1	1.6	Use the separated 2-way bike path on Tillary Street.
Right	Cadman Plaza East/Washington Street	0.4	2.0	Moderately steep descent.
Left	York Street	0.1	2.1	
Left	Front Street	0.1	2.2	
Right	Old Fulton St	0.1	2.3	<b>Please dismount and walk bike to vantage point.</b>
<b>1</b>	<b>Pier 1 - View of Brooklyn Bridge and Governors Island Waterfalls</b>			
Turn Around	Old Fulton St/Cadman Plaza West	0.2	2.5	Put bike in low gear for the gradual ascent.
Right	Henry Street	0.3	2.8	Short, but moderately steep ascent - put bike in low gear to make the climb easier.
Right	Clark Street	0.2	3.0	At Brooklyn Heights Promenade entrance <b>dismount and walk bike</b> .
Straight/Left	Brooklyn Heights Promenade	0.3	3.3	Please <b>walk your bike</b> . View the Waterfalls anywhere along the Promenade.
<b>2</b>	<b>Brooklyn Heights Promenade - View of Brooklyn Piers and Governors Island Waterfalls</b>			
Straight	Brooklyn Heights Promenade	-	3.3	Continue walking your bike; rde bike starting at Remsen Street.
Left	Remsen Street	0.3	3.6	
Left	Clinton Street	0.2	3.8	Bicycle lane available.
Straight	Tillary Street Bike Path	0.1	3.9	Use the 2-way separated bike path; travel past the entrance to the bridge on the service road. For reference a police vehicle is parked on the service road.
Left	Adams Street Service Road	0.3	4.2	Bicycle lane available.
Veer Right	Sands Street	0.1	4.3	Look for signage to the bridge path. At the intersection with Jay Street and under the Manhattan Bridge access the bridge bicycle path.
Right	Manhattan Bridge North Bicycle Path	0.8	5.1	Put bike in low gear for ascent on bridge. Stop at the Manhattan Tower to view the Waterfall.
<b>3</b>	<b>Manhattan Bridge North Bicycle Path-Manhattan Tower - View of Pier 35 Waterfall</b>			
Continue Straight	Manhattan Bridge North Bicycle Path	0.5	5.6	Slow down on the approach to Canal Street; sharp turn. Be prepared to stop at traffic signal.
Right	Canal Street	0.1	5.7	Traffic signal.
Right	Allen Street/Pike Street	0.4	6.1	Bicycle lane available.
Left	East River Greenway Bikeway	0.4	6.5	
Right	Montgomery Street Pedestrian Access	0.1	6.6	<b>Please dismount and walk bike to vantage point.</b>
<b>4</b>	<b>Pier 36 Viewing Area - View of Pier 35, Brooklyn Bridge and Governors Island Waterfalls</b>			
Turn Around	Montgomery Street Pedestrian Access	0.1	6.7	
Left	East River Greenway Bikeway	0.8	7.5	Viewing Pier is located immediately after the Brooklyn Bridge.
Stop	Viewing Pier at Dover Street	-	7.5	
<b>5</b>	<b>Viewing Pier at Dover Street - View of Pier 35, Brooklyn Bridge, Brooklyn Piers and Governors Island Waterfalls</b>			
Return to Bikeway	East River Greenway Bikeway	-	7.5	
Left	East River Greenway Bikeway	0.8	8.3	Additional vantage points are located at Piers 17, 16, and 11. Bathrooms, water, food available at Piers 17 & 11.
(Stop to board the ferry to Governors Island)	Battery Maritime Building	-	-	Obtain ferry schedule prior to arrival.
<b>6</b>	<b>Governors Island - View of Governors Island and Brooklyn Piers Waterfalls</b>			
(Reboard the ferry to return to Manhattan)	Battery Maritime Building	-	-

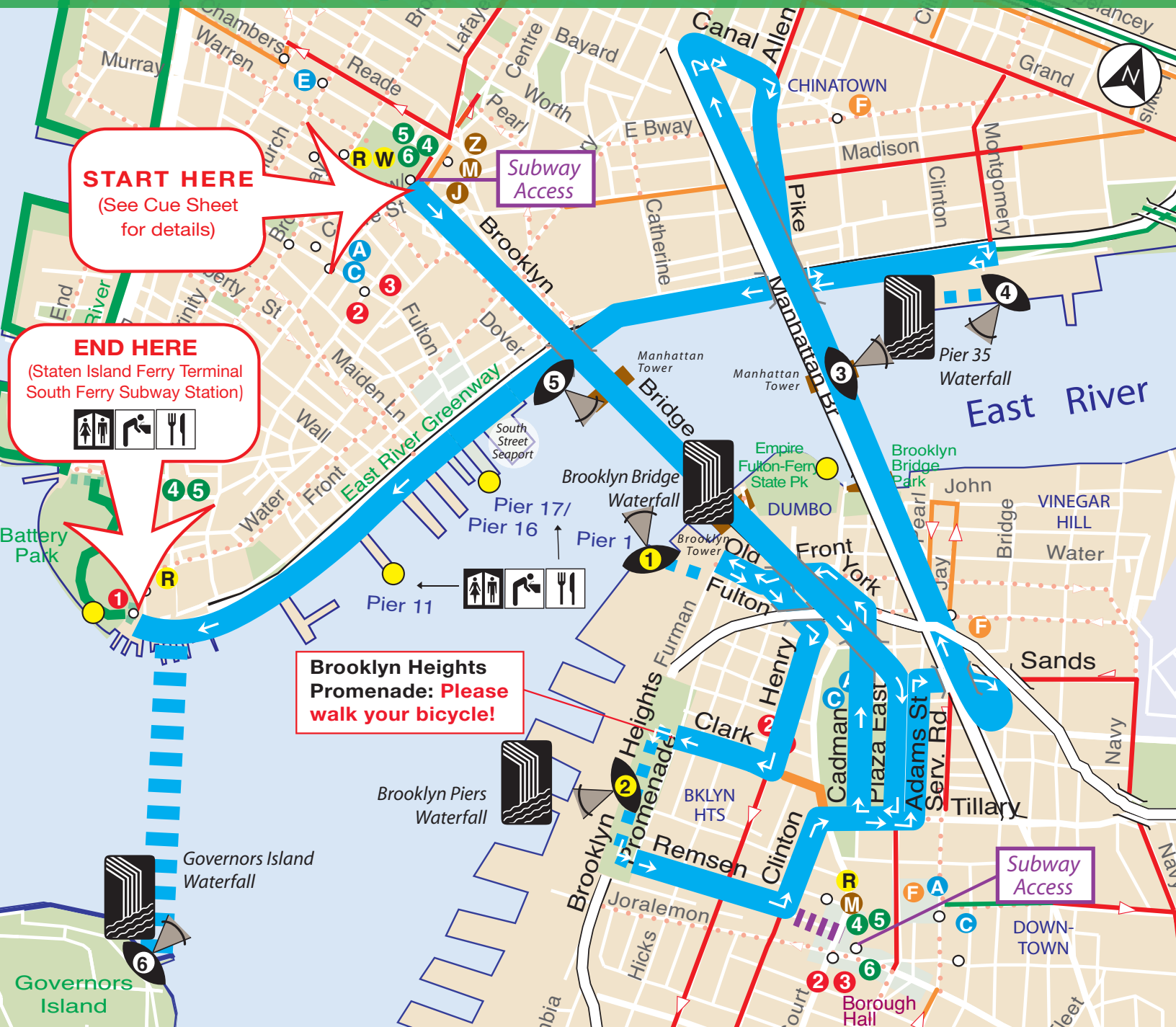


