

# People First on Clove Road

**PROBLEM:** Clove Road is a busy street between two popular parks with no bike lanes or pedestrian safety measures to protect locals from dangerous traffic.

- Two pedestrians have been killed on Clove Road over the last decade, and dozens more injured.
- Thousands of New Yorkers visit Clove and Silver Lake Parks annually, but feel unsafe accessing the parks on foot or bicycle.
- Dangerous streets like Clove Road are bad for local businesses.



**SOLUTION:** Install crosswalks and bike lanes on Clove Road

- Bike lanes and crosswalks reduce lethal speeding and increase pedestrian safety
- These safety improvements will empower local residents with safe access to more transportation choices and improve access to open space.
- Bike lanes and pedestrian safety improvements are proven to boost local businesses.
